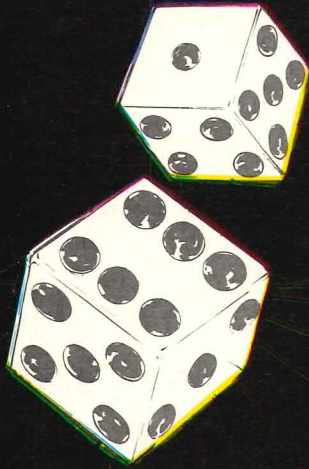

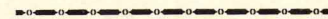

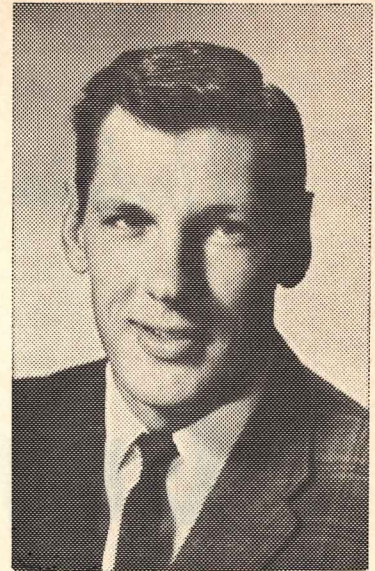

"GUYS AND DOLLS"

An Interpretation by W. O. Mitchell, Canadian Novelist and Playwright

Except for prima donna New York taxi drivers, it is quite possible that the raffish and sardonic crew of Damon Runyon's people does not have a real life counterpart; they belong only to an amoral and sentimental cloud cuckoo land suspended just above Broadway, a Runyonesque world of guys and dolls and Mindy's cheesecake and strudel, of Nicely Nicely Johnson, Harry the Horse, Liver Lips Louie, Angie the Ox, chorus girls, street hawkers and street walkers, gangsters and gamblers. This is the world of the present tense speakers, the dry, wry wits, parochial city sparrows engaged in larceny and violence, almost all with hearts of sentimental gold and ironically untarnished innocence. The poetry of earth is overlaid with asphalt and concrete; the green element is simply what you can put down or take up in a poker or floating crap game.

This should have been a rich territory for Sarah Brown, the sergeant lass from the Save-a-Soul Mission, but there

are few takers for the sort of uplift action she has to offer . . . until Sky Masterson hits town from Reno and Las Vegas, heavy with fifty G's won at black jack. Just as Sarah is a good little doll, Sky is a good non-welching guy, though he claims a heart as "black as two feet down a wolf's gullet." But a guy who has read the Gideon Bible twelve times and once won five G's with a triple bet on Shadrach, Mischach, and Abednego, is a challenge to a little doll like Sarah. Once their lives have crossed, no odds maker could possibly compute the permutations and combinations of their love story. One thing only can be certain in this world and the world of Damon Runyon:

"Marry the man today

Rather than sigh and sorrow

Marry the man today

And change his ways tomorrow."

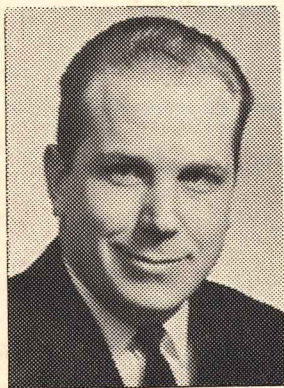

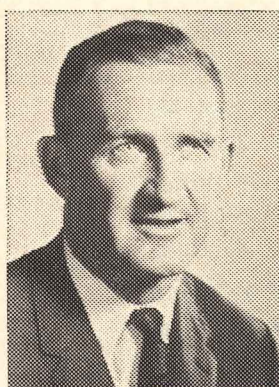

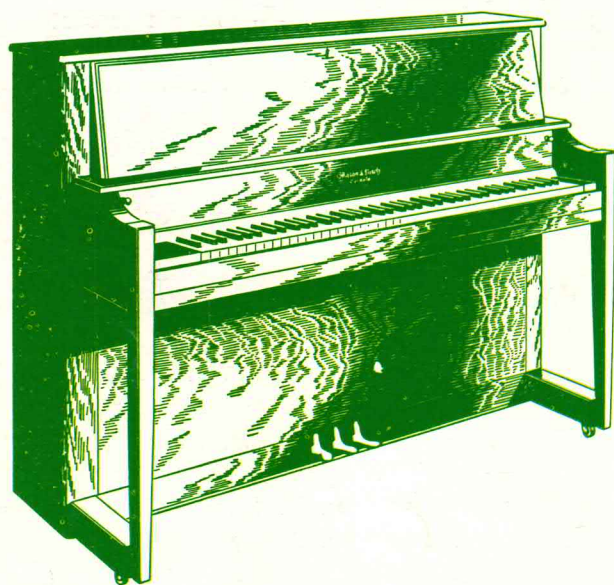
