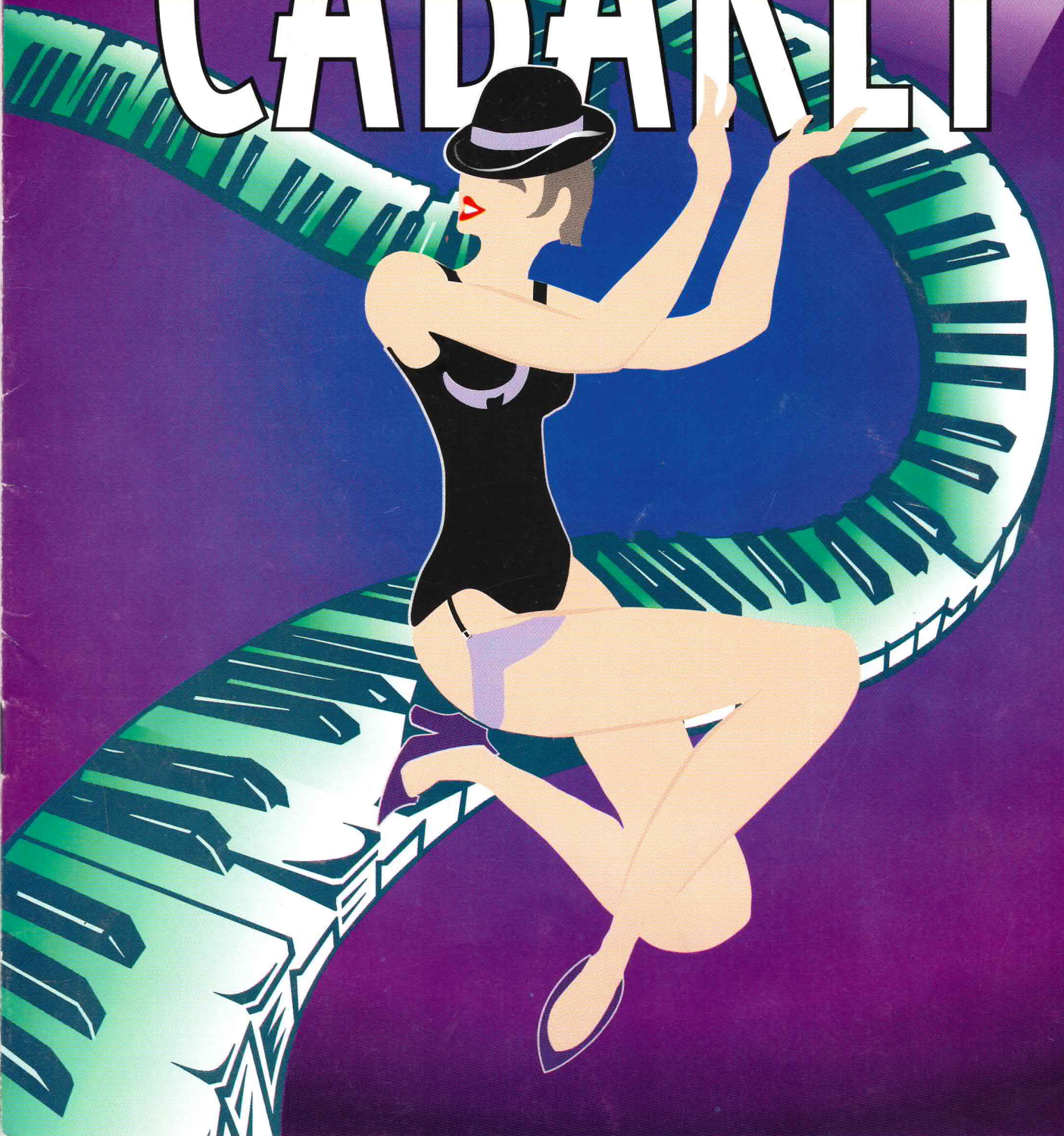
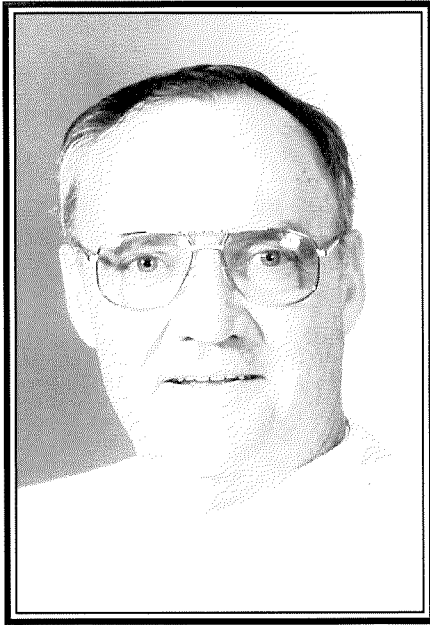

President's Message

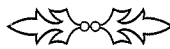
Medicine Hat Musical Theatre is privileged to present "Cabaret" as its current production.

To the many patrons who have supported us through the years, Thank you.

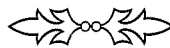
