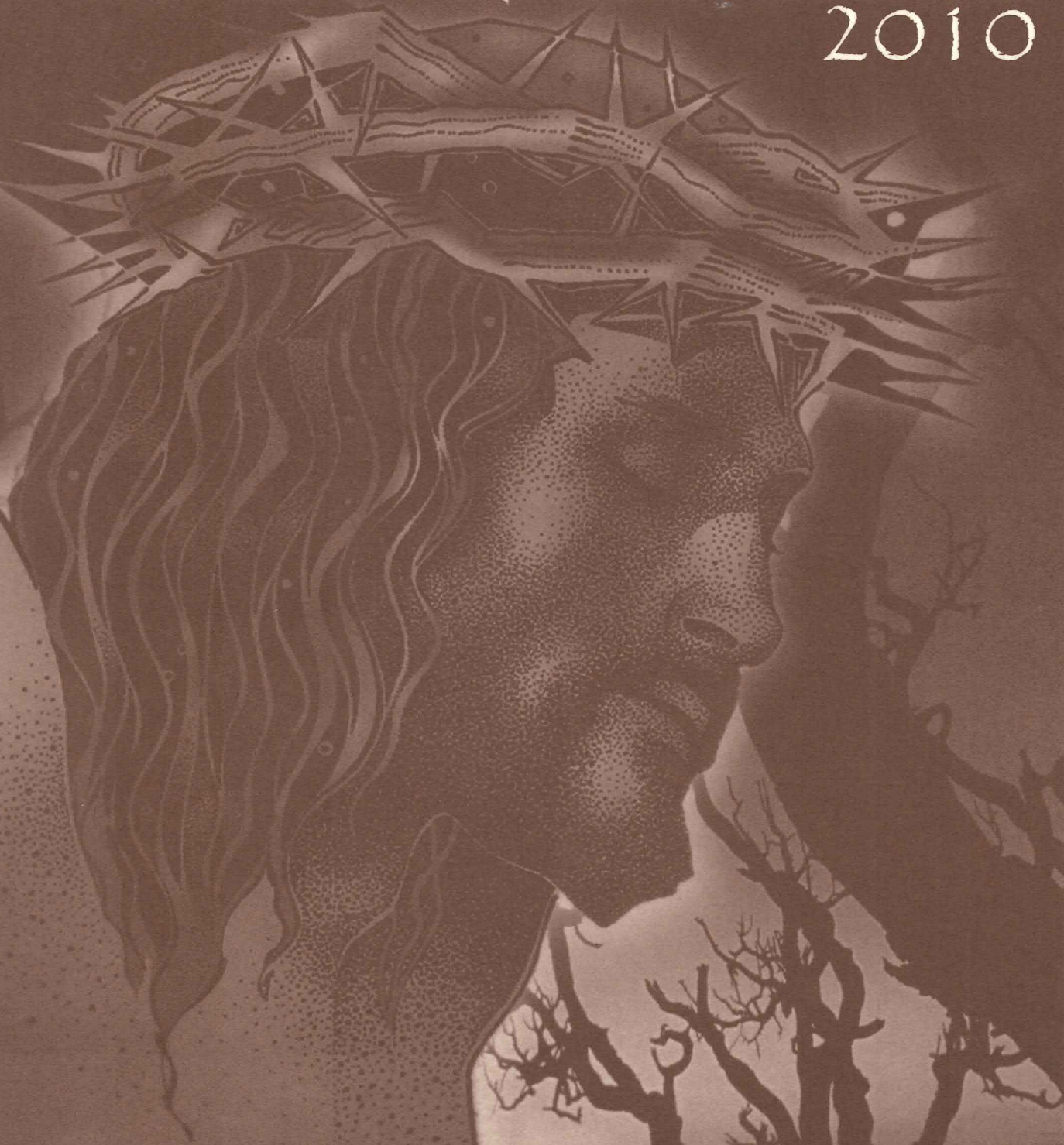

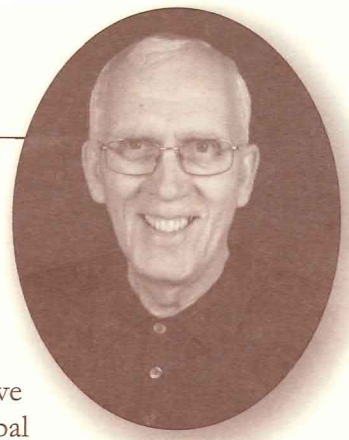

Joey Sabourin



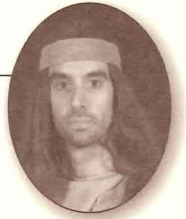

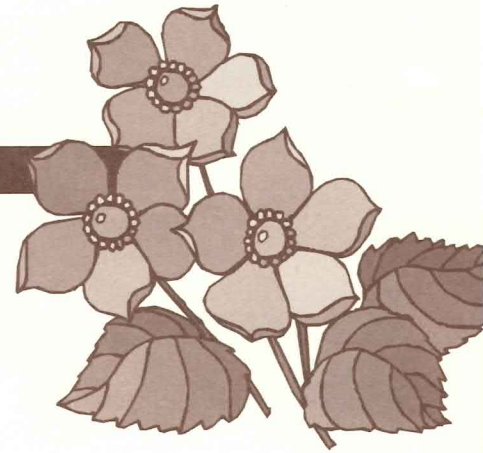


Bruce Sandford
