



The story of Rudolph was originally created by employee Robert May as a colouring book for Montgomery Ward's department store in 1939 as part of the Christmas advertising campaign.

The names Rollo and Reginald were considered before the author, Robert L May, decided that the red-nosed reindeer would be called Rudolph

The song, "Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer" was recorded by Gene Autry in 1947 and immediately became a hit

The TV special featuring Yukon Cornelius, Hermey, and the Misfit Toys originally aired in 1964 and has run every Christmas since.

Hermey, the elf, was originally going to be named "Herbie"

Although the animations were filmed in Japan, the entire soundtrack for Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer (1964) was recorded in a studio near Yonge Street in Toronto, Ontario.

Most of the singing and speaking cast were Canadian, including the voices behind Hermey, Rudolph, Yukon Cornelius




